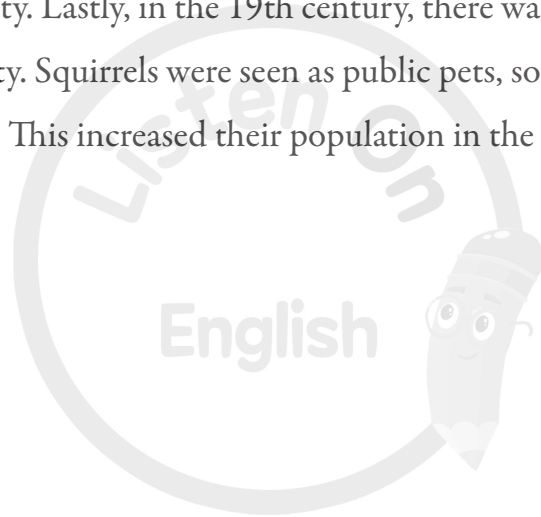




17. 언급된 도시가 아닌 것은?
